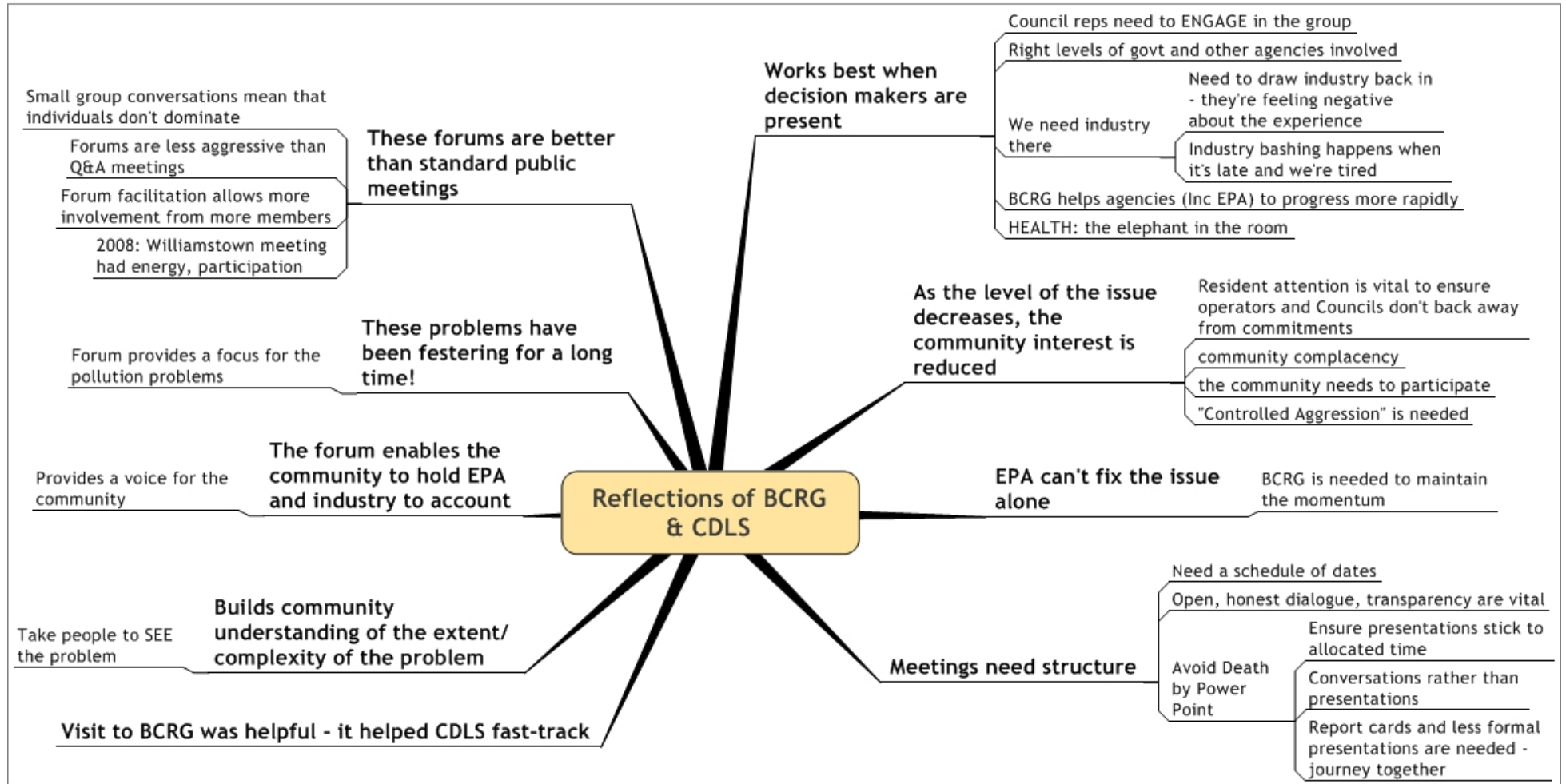

The meeting was expertly facilitated by Kimbra White.

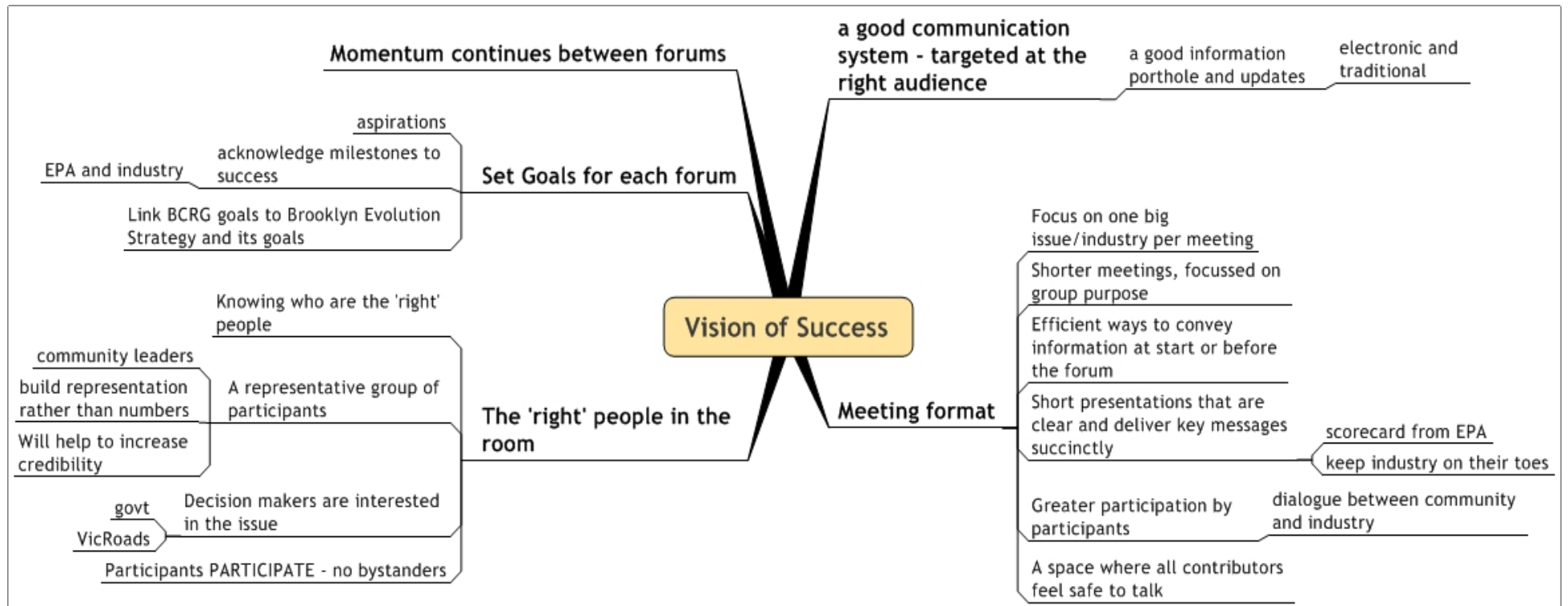
Our hopes and expectations for the meeting were discussed:
