On behalf of Friends of Lower Kororoit Creek (FOLKC), and our major sponsors Toyota Australia, Melbourne Water, Wyndham and Hobsons Bay City Councils and Millers Inn, I would like to invite you, along with your family, friends and colleagues, to a very special day along Kororoit Creek. On this day we are to celebrate the completion of the DSE Vision for Werribee Plains Project that is funding a section of the shared bicycle / walking trail linking the Kororoit Creek corridor to Brimbank and eventually Caroline Springs and also the Federation Trail to Werribee. The project has also enabled the commencement of the development of a 4 kilometre walking trail that will eventually link the Bluestone bridge to Barnes Road along the west side of the Kororoit Creek and provided a beautiful wetland along the walking Trail.

This event is to be conducted on Sunday 28 July 2013, commencing at 10am, and is coupled with National Tree Day, the most important day in the FOLKC calendar, when in excess of 150 participants are expected to attend. This event is more than a tree planting day; it is a major celebration of the Kororoit Creek waterway and brings together the local community with our sponsors and supporters and in particular Toyota personnel. Some of the activities on the day include:

- The planting of approximately 1500 indigenous trees and shrubs;
- Our resident clown, Edvardo and his accordion, on site to entertain the attendees and hand out lollies and chocolate goodies to the children, donated by Nestle;
- Entertainment for the children including face painting, tee shirts and colouring books;
- Free tea, coffee, etc and hot food made available during the course of the morning catered by the Altona Lions; and
- A free BBQ sponsored by Bakers Delight and Cedar Meats Australia.
