Project Timeline:

Project to date:

- 1. Melbourne Water and VicRoads gave the necessary go ahead for the project to commence.
- 2. Poisoning of weeds, boxthorn, etc., has been undertaken both by VicRoads and Friends of Lower Kororoit Creek.
- 3. The filling of the trail has commenced with Burns Earthmoving bringing in fill and topsoil to the site between Jones Road and Old Geelong Road.
- 4. Mulch has been delivered and distributed on site for the southern and northern boundaries of the Federation Trail between Geelong Road and Old Geelong Road. The northern side between Jones Road and Old Geelong Road will be completed once the drainage of Jones Road has been completed.
- 5. Crushed brick has been delivered and laid along the northern side of the trail as an all weather access maintenance track and walking path for non-cyclists.
- 6. The planting of the site is planned for June 2014.

Australian Tallow Site Works:

The mulched mound has been built along the boundary and the site has been fenced off. The mound is to be planted in 2014 with indigenous trees and shrubs that will blend in with the landscaping proposed for the trail.
