Transpacific and Melbourne Water invite the Brooklyn community to a planting event along Kororoit Creek.

> The Event

Transpacific and Melbourne Water seek community assistance with planting 500 indigenous trees and shrubs to remediate the western side of the Kororoit Creek, adjacent to the former landfill at the Old Geelong Road site.

Our aim is to recreate a durable and sustainable natural landscape along the Kororoit Creek that will require low maintenance once established. The existing vegetation is dominated by Artichoke Thistles, blanket weed, Boxthorn, Kikuyu Grass and many other weed species.

This trial planting exercise will enable us to assess and refine our plans for a progressive planting program along the remainder of the Kororoit Creek in 2015.

Lunch and refreshments will be served. Warm comfortable clothing and appropriate footwear are recommended, gloves are provided.


