






## Air Quality Update

#### **Rolling 12 month exceedence count**






# Progress: Priority 1 (Roads)

- Verges work
  - Works to remove build up of soil.
  - Verges seeded, or crushed rock applied
  - Vehicles driving and parking on newly treated areas is a problem
- Alternative roads modelling
  - VCAT decision has halted works on Jones and Bunting Roads
  - EPA has modelled alternatives to sealing both roads
